When we sought legal advice we were told the only legal way to cancel the contract would be to return to the house as occupants ourselves, which was in fact a very real need, since without the rent we are unable to keep paying our rent in Alcalá. So, we had one month to move back into our house.

We really felt that we didn't have the energy and would be unable to pull

it off. But the Lord, once again, showed his love and kindness, and, through the incredible help of some Christian brothers from Granada, Alcalá and Cabra, we were able to get it all done. We are so very grateful for all of them!! Since the end of May we've been living, once again, in Cabra.

Although the return to Cabra was necessary, we are convinced that it is time to move to a new project outside of Andalucia. For that reason we see our stay in Cabra as transitory. The immediate plan is to put our house on the market in order to be able to buy another house wherever God would have us live.
